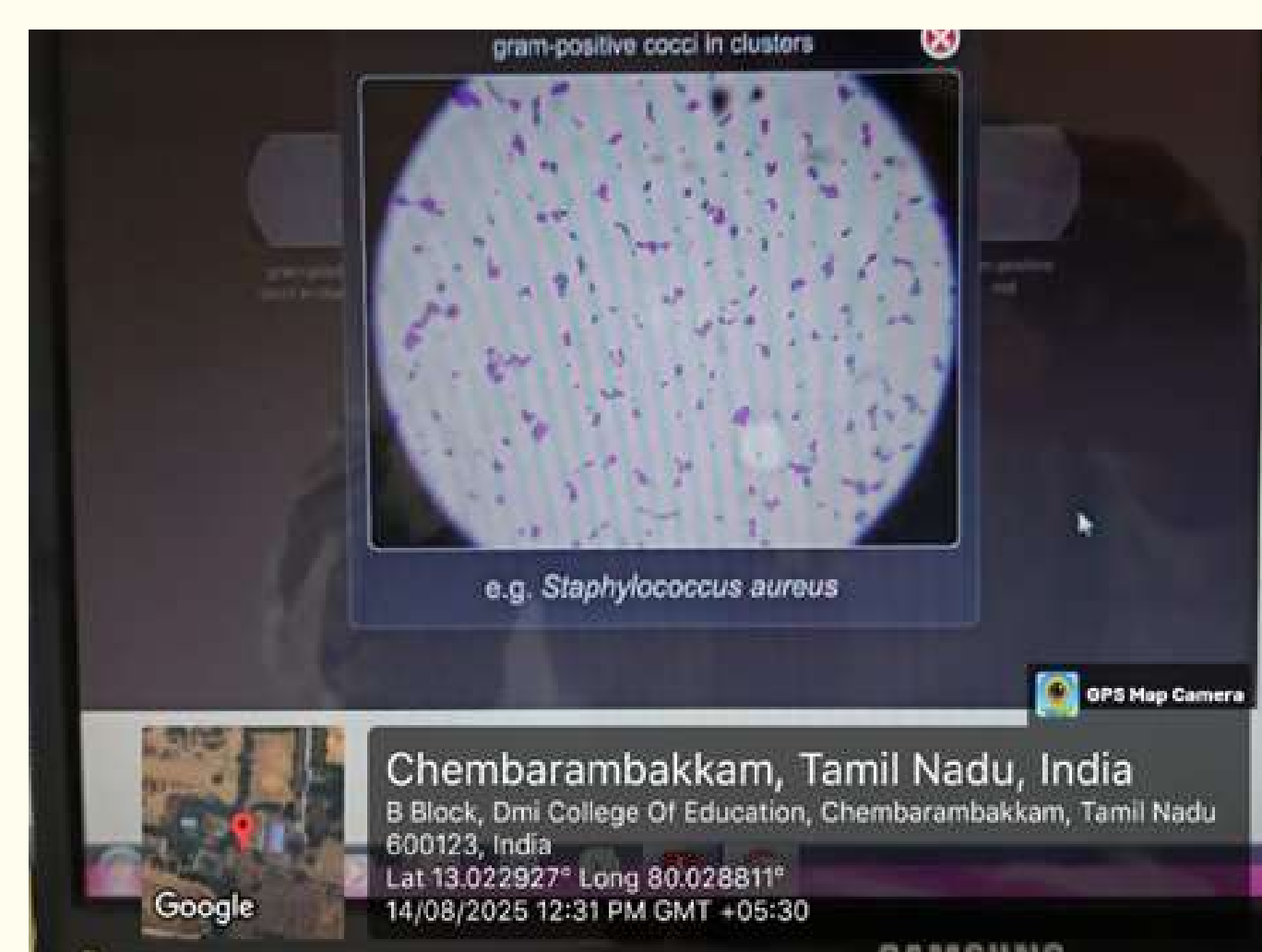
Inaugural Ceremony – Undergraduate Engineering Program

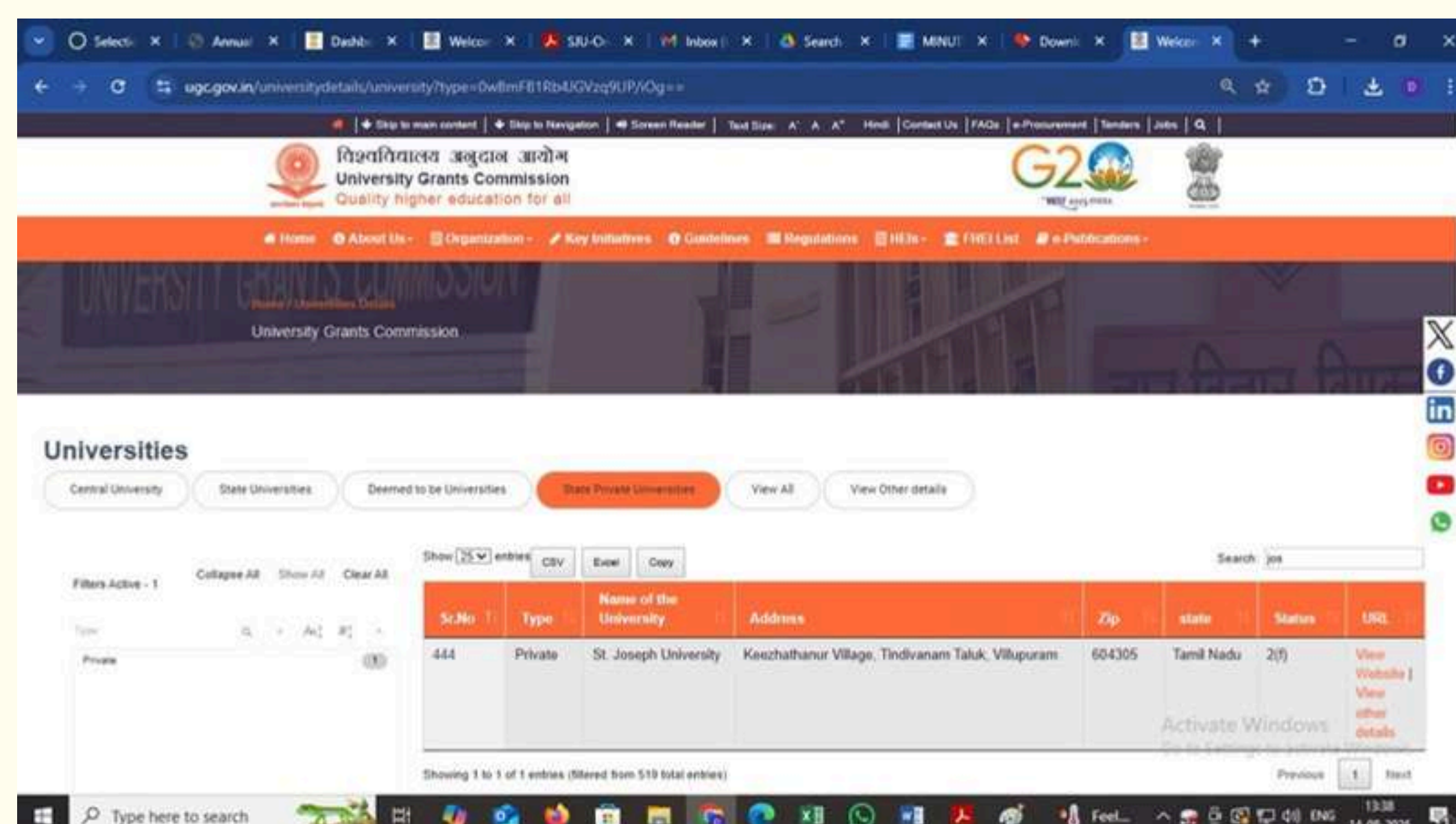
A meeting was conducted to review the previous admission efforts, follow up on enquiries, and discuss further plans for strengthening the admission process.

St. Joseph University has received the approval of the University Grants Commission (UGC) in August 2025, the same was officially added to the UGC website.

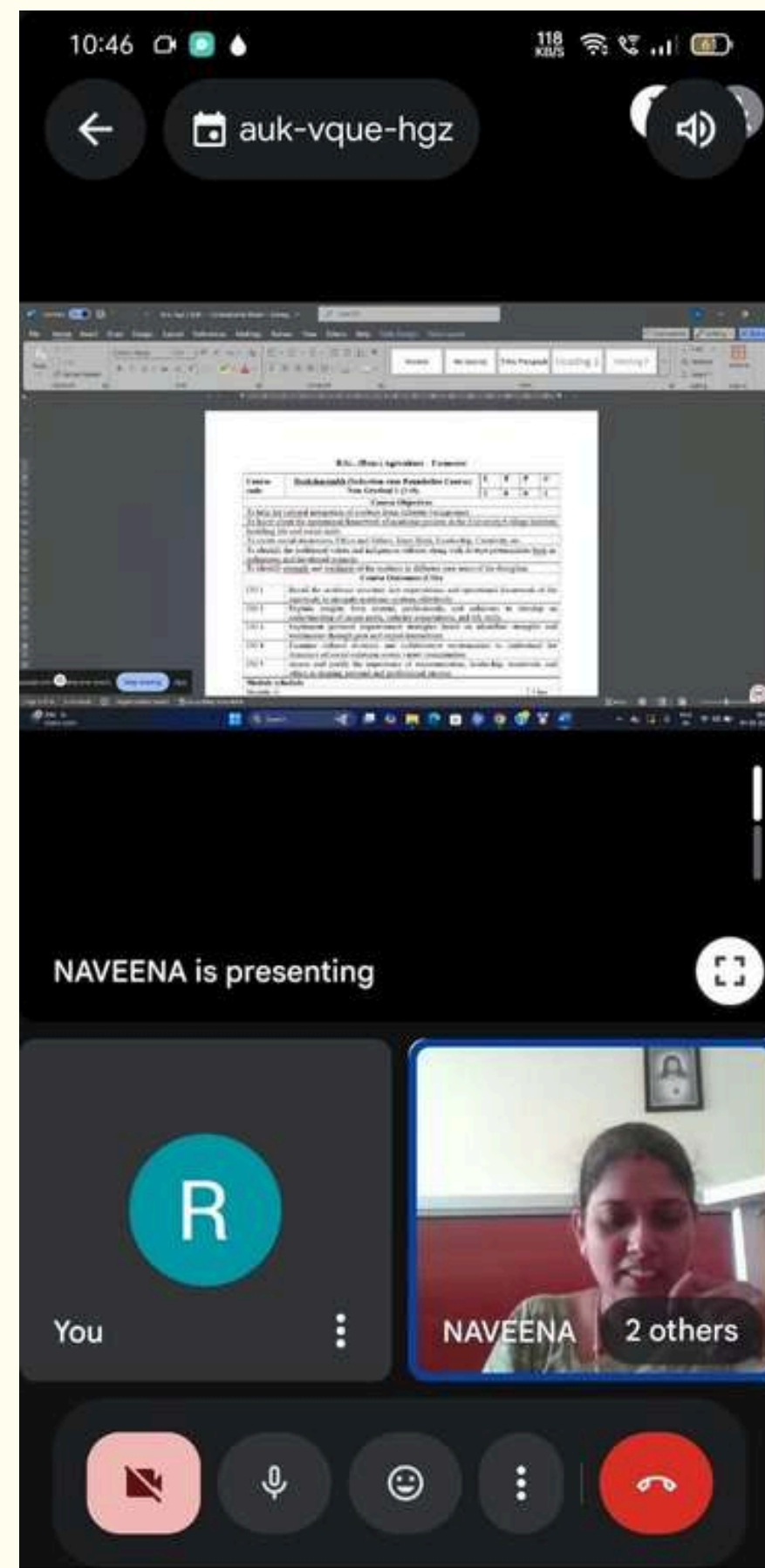
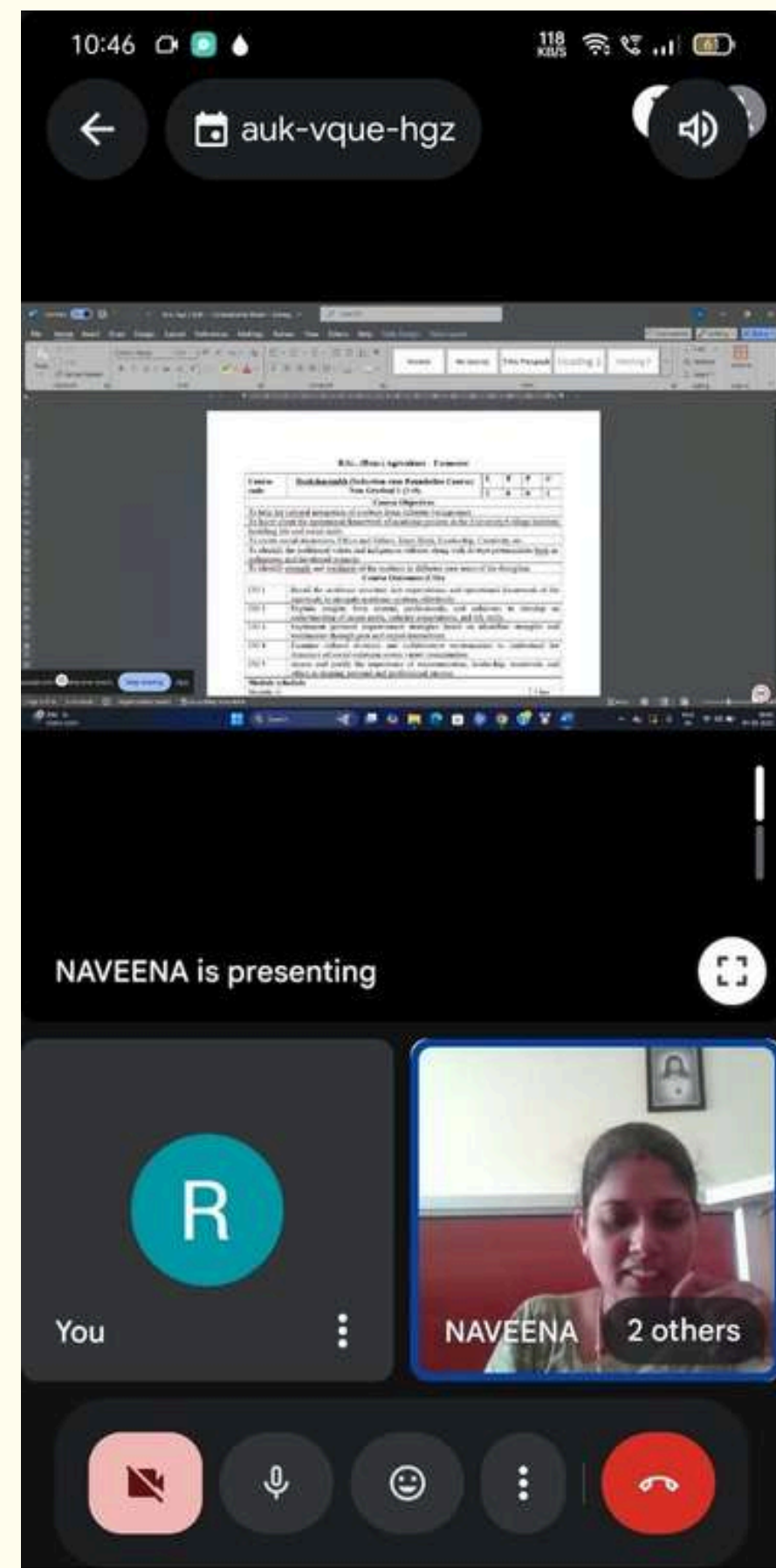

Anti-Ragging Day was observed on 16-08-2025, during which faculty and students together took the anti-ragging pledge.



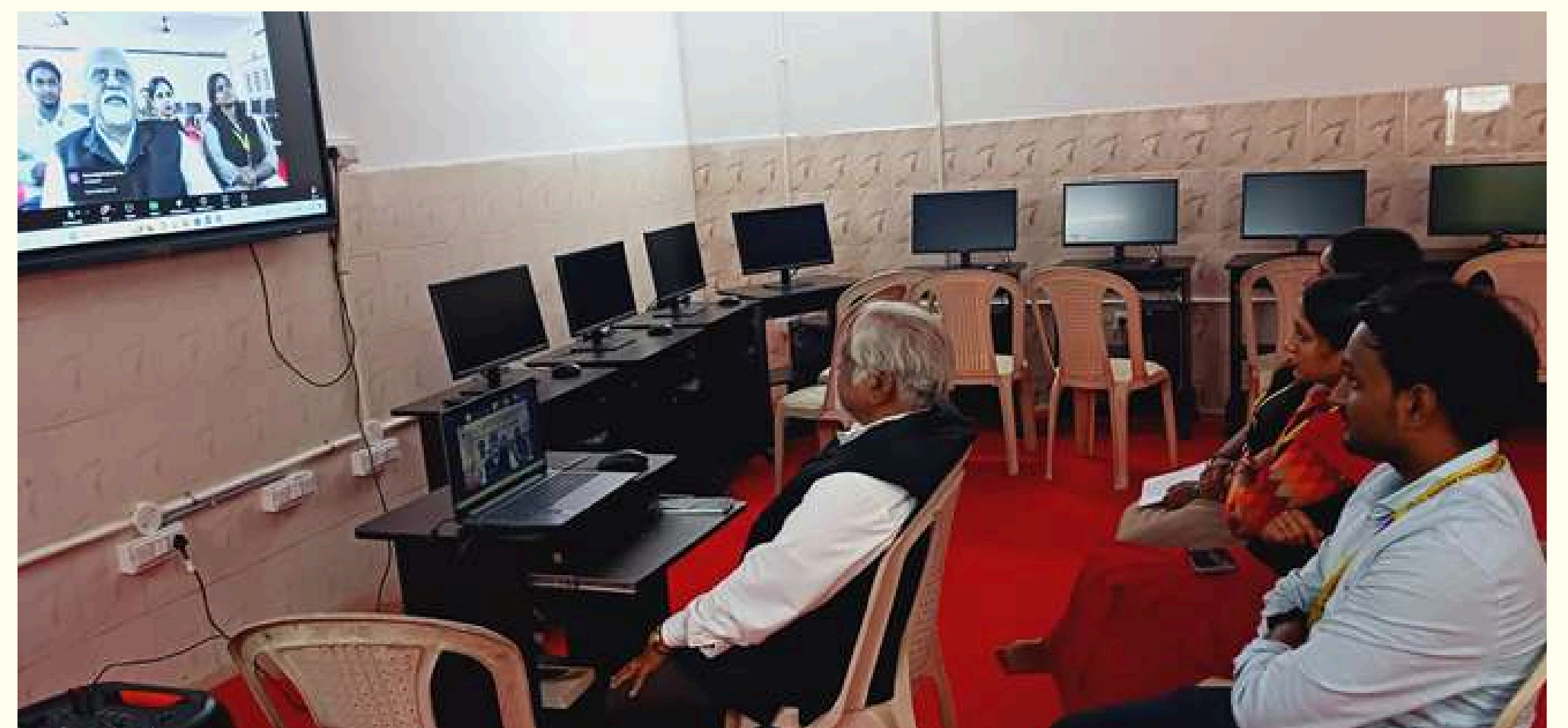


SCHOOL OF LAW CAMPUS HIGHLIGHTS

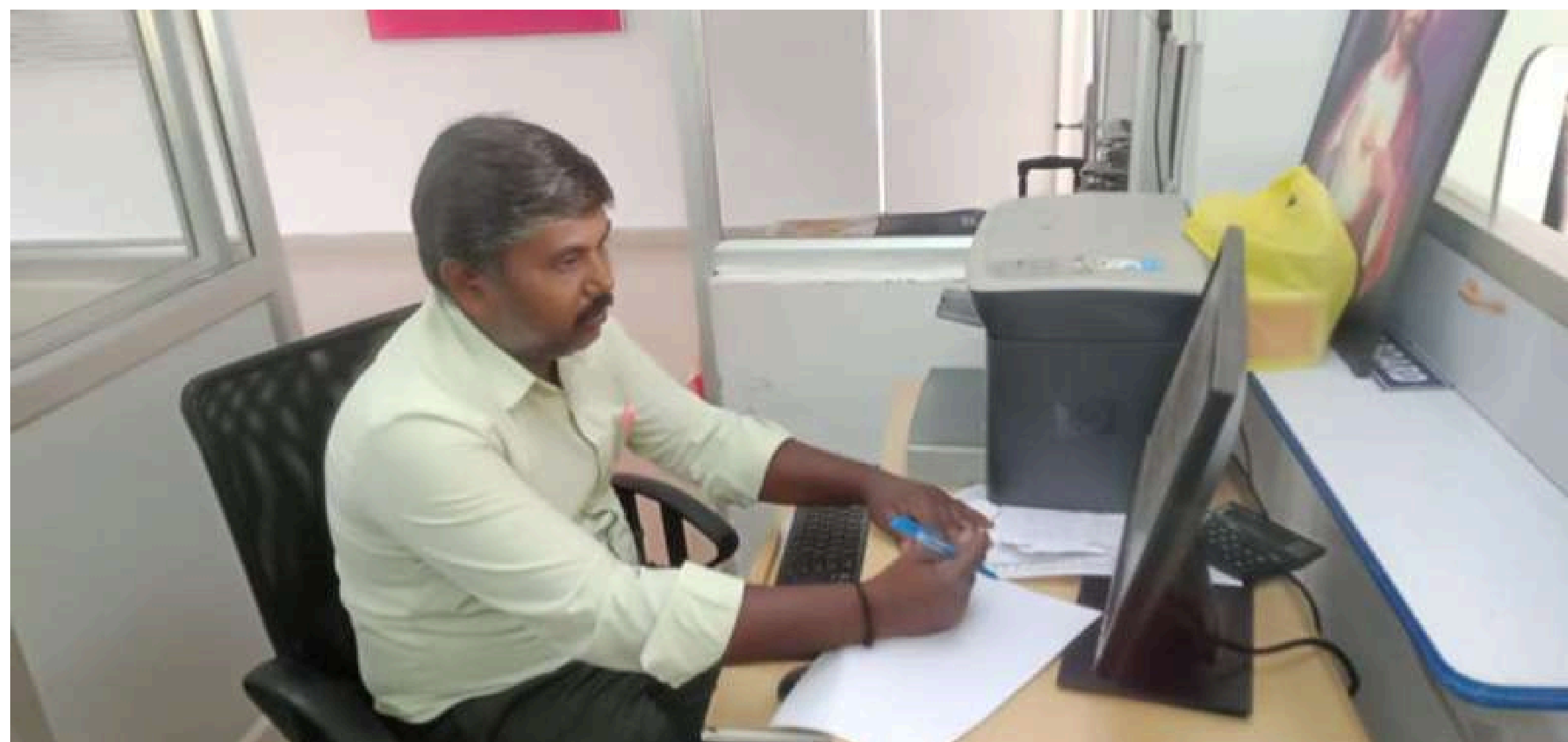

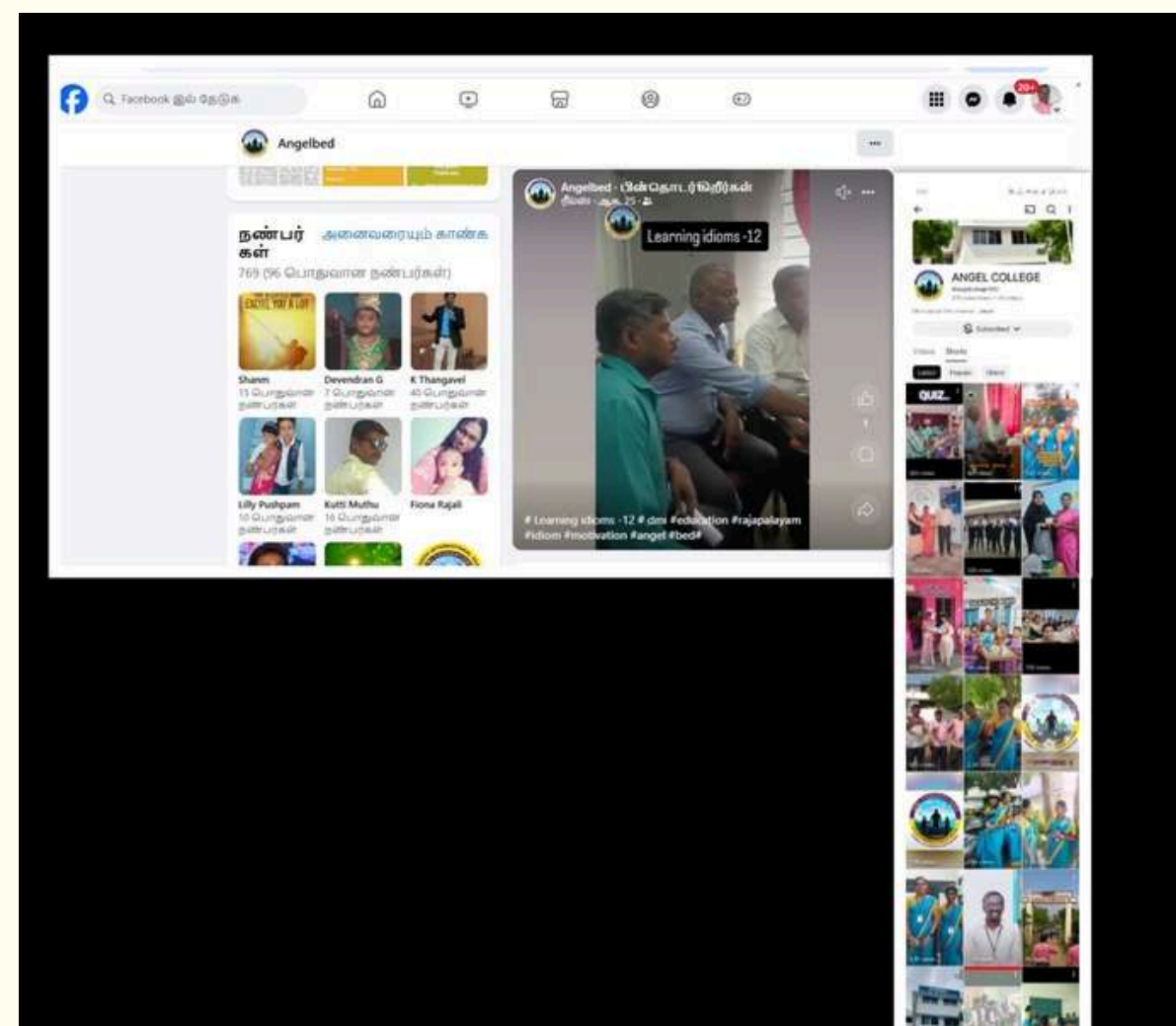

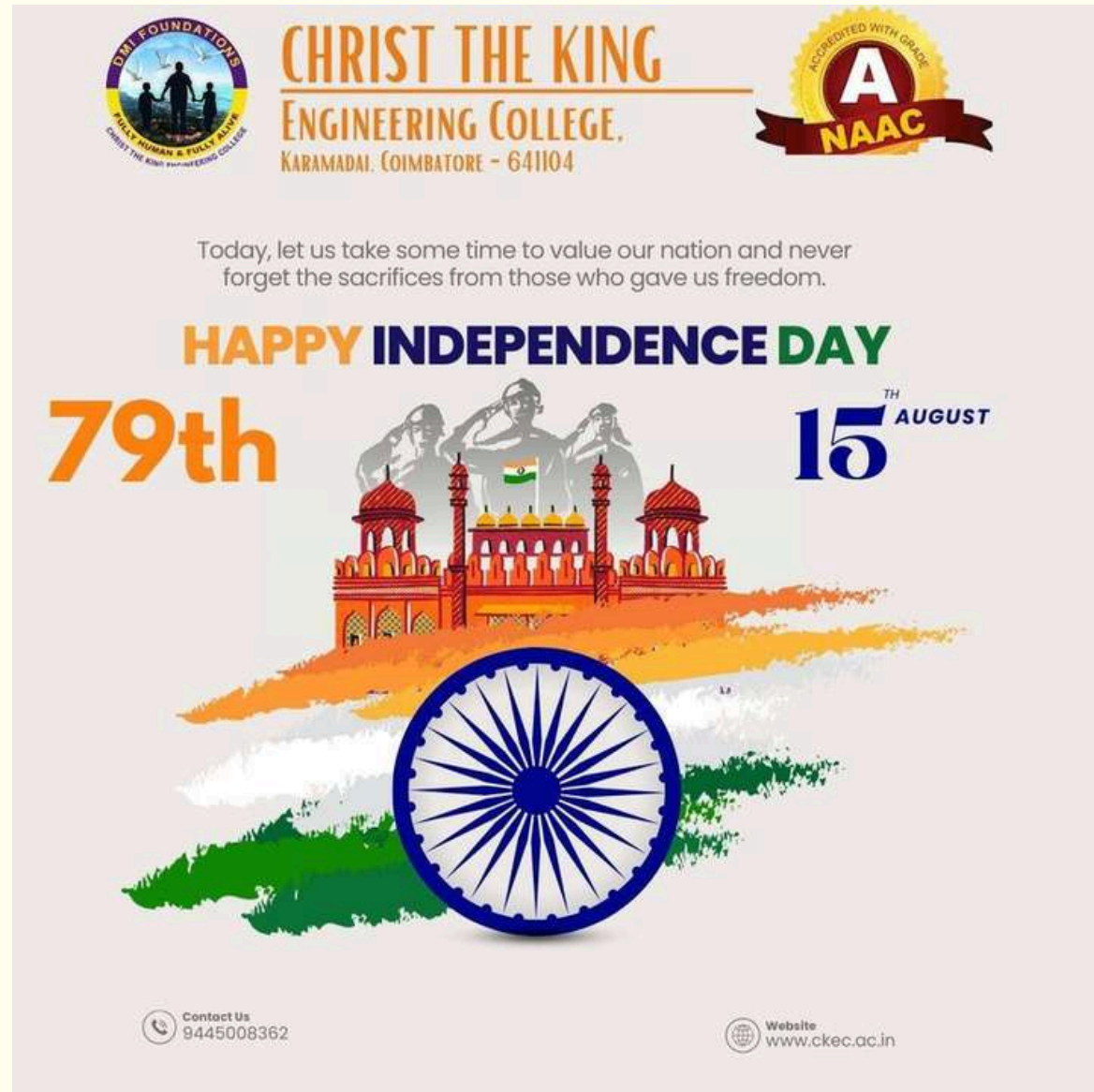

Ensuring Student Convenience and Confidence: A Smooth Start to TNTEU Examinations

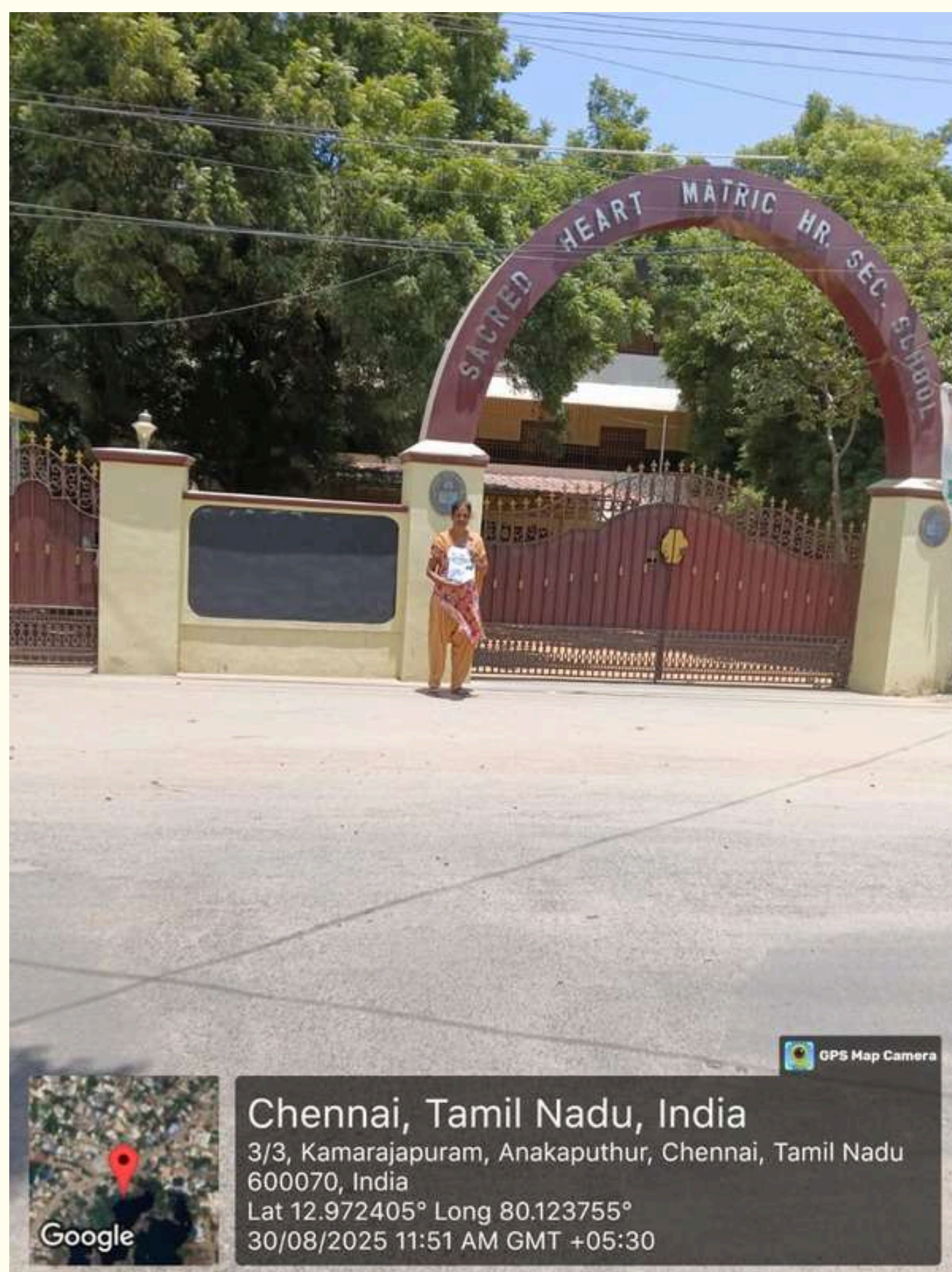

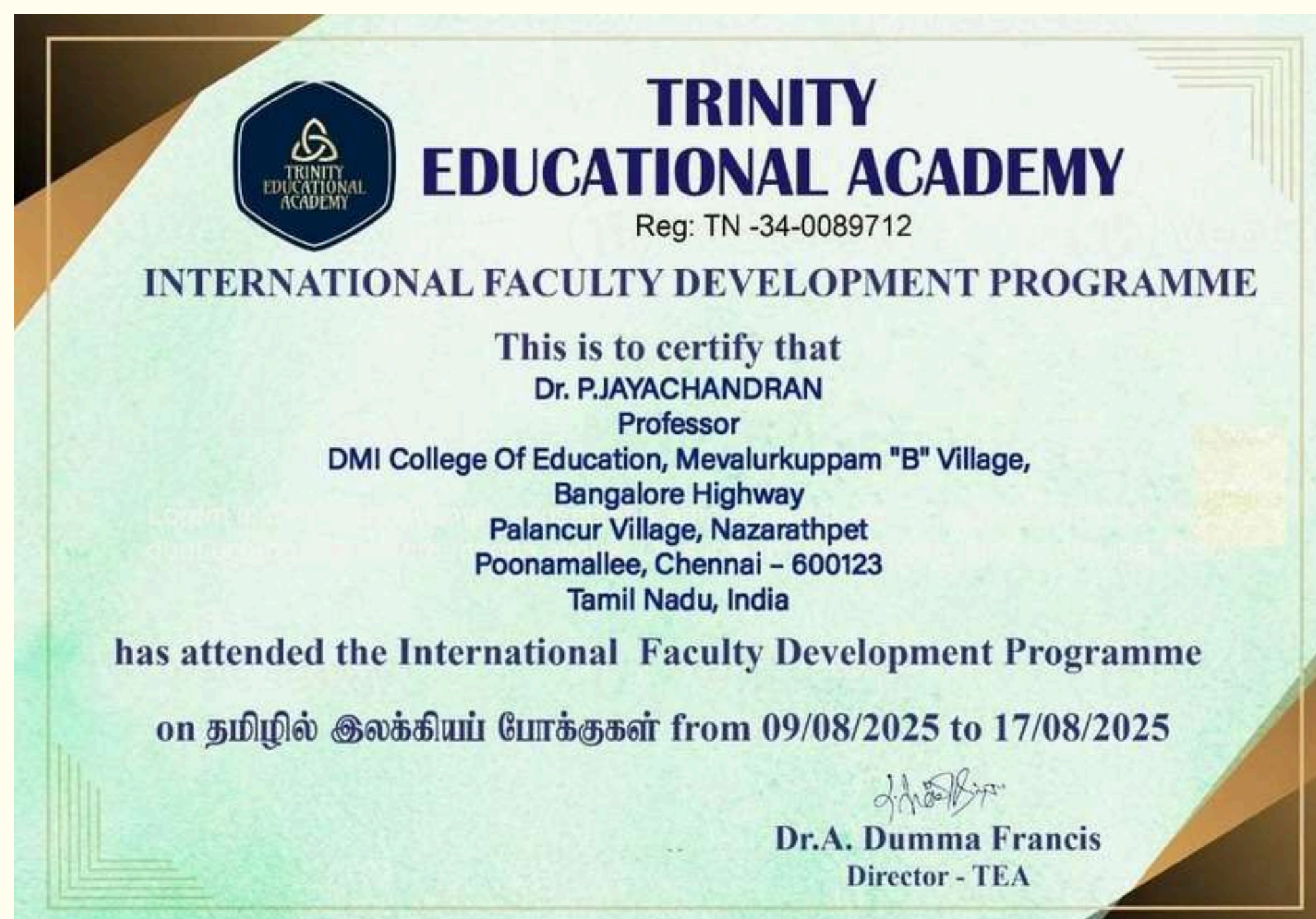


Dr. P. Jayachandran Attends International Faculty Development Programme

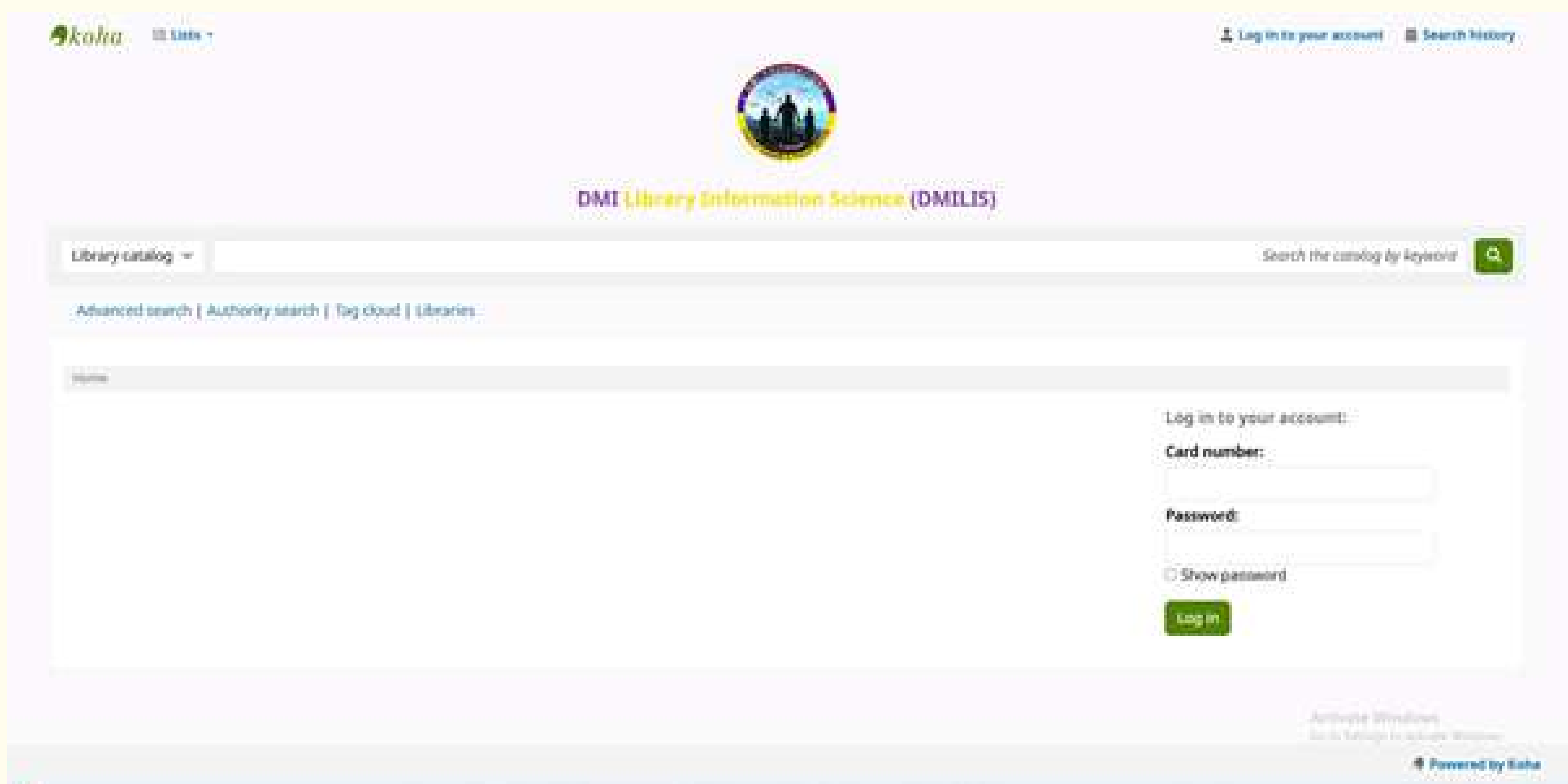
Bio-metric Integration Across 9 Colleges
